Some big thinking news over the last couple of weeks about the 'tragedy of the horizon' (this denotes a behavioural / economic phenomenon where certain risks may exceed the management (Risk Horizon) of most actors, imposing a cost on future generations of actors that the current generation has no direct incentive to fix).
